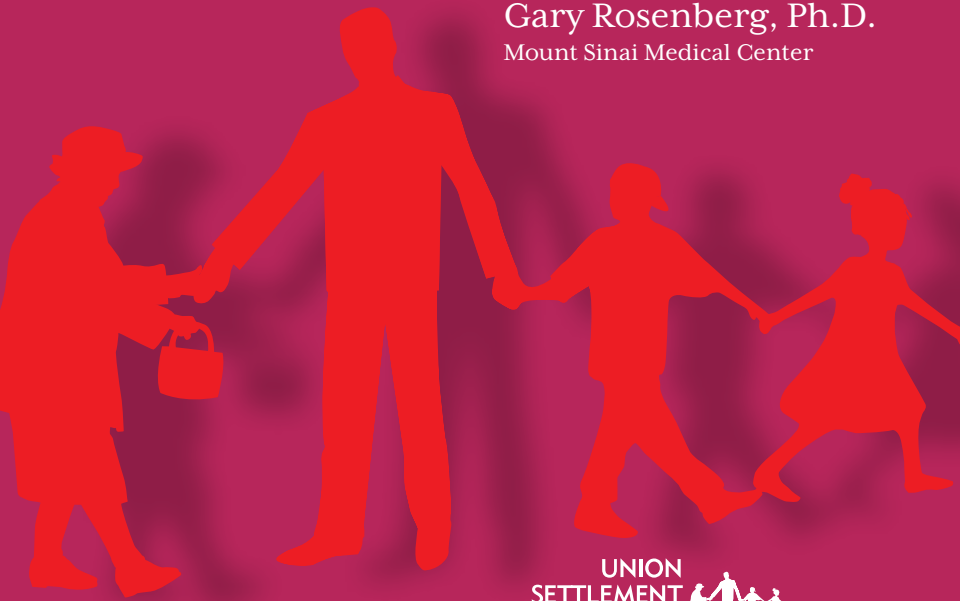

## **FACT**

**East Harlem residents do not have enough food in their homes. They seek meal programs more than any other neighborhood in Manhattan**
