### **Position Summary:**

The ESL Teacher is a part-time position that includes teaching adults listening, speaking, writing and reading skills in English.

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Teach ESL Level 1, or ESL Level 2 and/or Level 3 course.
- Prepare and make copies of pertinent instructional materials.
- Collaborate with teaching staff regarding lesson plans, etc.
- Take daily attendance and maintain minimum student attendance as outlined by contracting agency or funder.
- Complete in-take forms and create a file for each student.
- Administer *Best Plus Exam* pre-test and post-test for students in each class.
- Maintain communication with Director of Adult Education about class activities and progress.
- Submit student attendance, in-take forms, and testing information to Program Assistant by established deadlines.
- Additional duties as assigned by Director of Adult Education.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Bachelor's Degree in Education or related field.
- At minimum two years' experience teaching ESL to adult populations.
- Best-Plus Certification required.
- Experience working with urban adults and immigrants.
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- Excellent communication, organizational, verbal, and written skills.
- Demonstrated ability to perform multiple tasks effectively in a fast-paced, challenging, and constantly changing environment.
